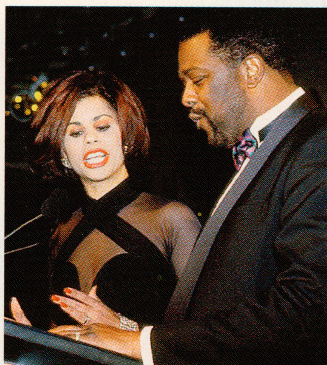
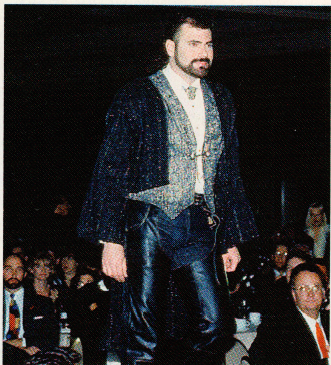
LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT, TRUSTEES AWARD

Each year, the North American Hairstyling Awards sponsors elect a recipient of the Lifetime Achievement Award, presented to an individual for his or her talent, skill, experience and contribution to the professional salon industry.

The award was presented posthumously to Paul Mitchell in 1991, Vidal Sassoon in 1992 and to Leo Passage last year.
